Supporting Your Child At Home...with ideas for writing! (part 3)

The real hook...

Ask your child to imagine they are treasure hunters and that they have been transported into the picture.

Use the words you collected in parts 1 & 2 to tell them a short story, which focuses on their senses.

Encourage them to picture the scene and imagine that the living room or garden is now a desert island.

Send them off in role to find some treasure. You could hide glittery pebbles, bits of shiny bric-a-brac or stickers for them to find, but rest assured they will come back with an armful of goodies.



Children love physical activities like this. Their imagination drives their creativity. In my experience, they will not only find what you have hidden, but an awful lot of things you didn't!!!
